## How to quickly take notes of lectures? "The benefits of abstracts

A synopsis is a concise written content of a covered topic, which allows you to recall and remember new information when preparing your homework.

The student begins to write his first notes in high school, and in the Russian language even the topic is provided: "How to properly take notes of lectures."

## Overview of Notes

So, the lecture notes reflect the topics of the lecture, and in all details and with an emphasis on the main idea.

Each student must take notes, and for this, come to the lecture with a notebook and a set of colored pens.

As a rule, the note-taking of a new topic begins with the date and title, and so that the inscriptions do not merge, it is advisable to deviate a few lines from the previously covered material.

Strong points and important thoughts need to be highlighted with color, and written so that when you come home, the content of a new topic does not turn into a real charade.

If a student does not know how to correctly take notes, then he should turn to the help of the World Wide Web or visit a school teacher of the Russian language.

From old memory, she will surely refresh the knowledge that was missed in due time, teach you how to correctly draw up a synopsis, and then successfully use it in the next preparation for the upcoming session.

If we talk about the benefits of abstracts, then you should definitely highlight the following points:

- replaces textbooks and visits to the student library;
- becomes an excellent cheat sheet for the exam;
- contains only important information on the topic, that is, it is written "without water";
- repeats the teacher's valuable thoughts on the topic;
- does not take up a lot of space in a backpack;
- guarantees a basic level of knowledge of the subject;
- becomes a legal tip in practical training;
- trains memory and speed of writing;
- participates in the final grade in the subject;
- characterizes the student from the exemplary side.

So it is quite obvious that this thing is simply irreplaceable among students, and it is advisable not to throw away the written-down notebooks, but to keep them for the future: you never know, it will come in handy when defending a diploma, or you can find a hint to an important question already in the status of a "young specialist".

Smart people, even at the age of 40, sacredly keep their student notes: some, as a memory, and others, as an inexhaustible source of valuable information at all times.
