Significant information relative to the origin of Tutankhamon is not yet found. It is known about the archaeologists found by the archaeologists from the Hermopol, which includes the following inscription: "Pharaoh's beloved Son from his flesh Tutanyhaton."

Now experts in an ancient Egypt have 2 versions of the origin of Tutankhamon: he has to Son Pharaoh Ehnathon or his father was Pharaoh Explahkar, son-in-law, brother or son of Ehnaton. In the late manuscripts of his reign, Tutankhamon calls the father of his native grandfather Amenhotep III, which is explained by the change in political and religious system.

In childhood, the boy was named Tutthanhaton, which means "the" Live embodiment of ATON ". By the way, under Aton, the solar disk, the deity and the visible form of the God of the Sun of the Republic of Armenia are meant. After the death of Ehnaton and return to the practice of the former Pantheon, for the 2nd year of his reign, he took another name - Tutankhamon ("Live embodiment of Amon).
