

How is student initiation going?

So, dedication!" Many applicants mistakenly believe that this tradition applies exclusively to overseas universities and American students.

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Indeed, we very often in youth comedy films observe how senior students in a student hostel maliciously play newcomers, as if initiating them into students.

In fact, this tradition can be safely called international, since it extends to all countries and continents.

Dedicated to students, both in the world famous Harvard, and in the domestic MGIMO, for example.

It all depends on the imagination of the senior students and their desire to "sweeten" the life of new entrants.

As a rule, such mass events are organized in a student hostel, and it is not for nothing that there is an expression: "If you have not lived in a hostel, then you are not a student."

That's right, all the most interesting and exciting takes place within the walls of the student dormitory, and even a strict commandant cannot prevent the inevitable.

From the life of cadets

It just so happened, dear reader, that there are a lot of sailors in my environment. Today they are - gallant and courageous officers, but 10 years ago they were cadets of the famous naval school named after I. P.S. Nakhimov in Sevastopol.

So they told me about the traditions, how they initiated new entrants in the fifth year. There were many stories, but only two were well remembered. It is worth talking about them in more detail.

First story. Being "dimes", back in September they chose from the freshmen of their own specialty the smallest, thinnest and most inconspicuous cadet who had to take the rap for the entire course.

Especially for him, a huge amount of sweets was bought in the buffet, which the "young" had to eat on his own.

It would seem that there is nothing complicated, especially since after the parental table it is difficult for freshmen to get used to the meager and limited menu of the cadet canteen.

But in fact, the amount of food that is offered to eat one at a time is simply unrealistic! But it is necessary - tradition obliges.

The dedication ends the moment only crumbs are left on the table! The freshman will be sick or not - the second question, but we can safely consider him as a cadet of Her Imperial Majesty (that's what they called themselves).

Second story. It is called "Chilling". Since this school of the Red Star is located on the very coast of the Black Sea, cadets have unhindered and round-the-clock access to sea water.

So why not take this opportunity to once again instill the love of freshmen for their future familiar environment - the sea. The idea is good, but the essence of the dedication is that "pyataks" take a full faceted glass (200 ml) of salt water and offer the newly elected to quench their thirst.

There is nothing to do, you have to drink, and a prerequisite is to swallow the entire contents of the glass in one gulp and not even frown. I know for sure that even experienced sailors sacredly honor this tradition, and cadets are no exception.

A person who has not encountered naval life before will say that this is nonsense, but all these are good old traditions of initiation, which have been passed from mouth to mouth for far from the first decade. So it is the duty of the future officer to fulfill them.

From the life of students
